

The Ministries of CFC Part II

The **CFC HELPS MINISTRIES** group are the ministries that handle many of the practical needs of the church. The first area of ministry in this category is **Church Lock-Up**. A team of men take turns making sure that the church is secured after every service.

Offering and Counters is a ministry organized by volunteers who take up the offering during services and oversees those who count and report the offering weekly.

Door Greeters are a very important part of CFC's ministry team. The **Door Greeter Ministry** is made up of some of CFC's friendliest people! Qualifications for this ministry include a warm smile, a firm hand shake, and an enthusiasm for CFC!

Parking Lot Attendants and **Ushers** are two other ministries included in the CFC Helps. *NOTE: PARKING IS NOT PERMITTED IN FIRE LANES---PLEASE PARK ONLY IN THE AREAS LINED OR IN THE LOWER LOTS.*

EXTENDED FELLOWSHIP is another group of ministries. The first ministry in this group, **Home Cell Groups**, are small groups that meet in individual homes to study God's Word together.

The Young Adult Ministry is open to individuals age eighteen to thirty, who are either single or married; with or without children. Their primary purposes are fellowship and spiritual growth through regularly planned activities.

The **Special Events Ministry** members help plan and execute special events in the church, such as fellowship dinners. There is always room in this ministry for those who enjoy serving others.

While most of these ministries exist to meet the needs of a spiritually vibrant church, they also exist to provide opportunity for members of the body of Christian Fellowship Center to serve the Lord. You don't need a special "talent" to contribute to any of the **Helps** or **Extended Fellowship Ministries**. You don't necessarily need "ability"; just availability. Everyone has *something* to contribute to the body of Christ at Christian Fellowship Center. What are you contributing?
