Worship is one of the “folds” of the three-fold focus of mission at Christian Fellowship Center. To facilitate the best possible worship within CFC’s services, there are a variety of ministries which make up the **MUSIC, MEDIA AND PERFORMING ARTS MINISTRY** category.

The CFC Music Minister is director of the **CFC Choir and Music Ministry**. He is the contact person for those interested in participating in worship leading; either instrumentally or vocally. The **CFC Music Ministry** exists for the sole purpose of magnifying and glorifying God through music. Music is the vehicle used to bring the congregation into one accord and to usher in the God-inspired message from our pastor. It is also an outreach ministry to the local community through special events and outreach to local nursing homes.

The Sound Ministry is a support ministry of the Music Ministry. The Sound Ministry provides technical assistance on Sunday mornings, Wednesday nights and special events. Participation in this ministry requires some “on the job” training of the use of the sound equipment and a “good ear”.

Did you know that every Sunday sermon, every Bible study teaching and every radio broadcast program is available on CD for only \$3.00, including postage? (\$2.00 for pick up) These are made available to you through another CFC ministry, **The CD Ministry**. Simply sign up at the reception desk to order CDs and tapes. If you want to review a message or spread the Truth to someone you know, the CD Ministry exists to assist you with that. These messages are also available online at www.scriptureknowledge.info for those who prefer Internet availability.

The **Video Ministry** includes computers, projectors, software, graphics and video. Technical assistance on Sundays and Wednesday nights is currently needed. If you have computer skills and are able to “focus” during the delivery of a message, please contact the church.

The **MUSIC, MEDIA, AND PERFORMING ARTS** ministries provide areas of opportunity for people in the congregation who possess certain skills. As we look to expand our choir and Music Ministry, we are actively seeking people who have previous experience, talent and/or skills playing instruments or singing. We are looking for people who desire to be “invisible” while being among the most visible in our church. We know that there are people in our congregation who once sang in high school, church or community choirs----*we need you*.
