YOUTH TRAINING AND SPIRITUAL GROWTH

The **CFC Children's Ministry** includes: Junior Church, Nursery, Keepers of the Home, Royal Rangers, and Sunday school for ages 3 to grade 5.

Junior Church classes are taught during the Sunday Worship Service. Bible teaching, special crafts, snacks and activities provide an enriched learning experience for CFC children who attend. There are currently two **Nurseries** available: Babies from birth to eighteen months are supervised by a parent in the **Cry Room** at the rear of the sanctuary. Moms or Dads can view and listen to the service in this baby proof room. Toddlers (18-36 mos) and their parent are accommodated in the **Toddler Nursery**; next to the kitchen. There, Moms and Dads can view the service on closed circuit TV in the comfort of a living room atmosphere with kid-friendly toys.

Keepers of the Home meets on Wednesday evenings at 7:00 PM. This ministry is for girls ages three through grade six. **Royal Rangers** is a ministry for young boys from kindergarten through grade twelve. Its purpose is to reach, teach, and keep boys for Jesus Christ. Boys have the opportunity to earn merits and medals for accomplishments. They also enjoy a variety of outdoor skills and activities. **Sunday school** classes are offered for children ages three through grade five. These ministries for children are always in need of solid, Christian men and women who model themselves after Christ, and enjoy working with children. (A clean background check is required.)

Another group of ministries is **Children's Special Events**. This includes **Vacation Bible School, Song Specials and Streamers**, and yearly events such as **Purity Afternoon**. **VBS** is both a ministry to CFC children and an outreach to the local community, held for one week in the summer. **Purity Afternoon** is an opportunity for young ladies to ask and have answered the "pressing" questions of life concerning relationships with the opposite sex.

Pierced Youth Group is CFC's primary ministry to teenagers. Bible understanding and application, body ministry and outreach to others have brought the teens closer in relationship to the Lord and each other through this group. The group meets twice a week on Sunday mornings and Wednesdays throughout the year; interspersed with outings, parties and activities that provide social opportunities for young Christian men and ladies.

There is one last ministry under the YOUTH TRAINING AND SPIRITUAL GROWTH ministries of CFC: **The Christian Fellowship Academy and High School**, dedicated to building leaders of academic excellence who engage the culture with a biblical worldview. .
