

The Ministries of CFC

Did you know that CFC has a total of 43 para-church ministries, including Christian Fellowship Academy? These ministries are overseen by our Deacon Board, which currently consists of nine men. Each Deacon is assigned one or more “groups” of ministry for which they oversee and function as a liaison from the congregation to the church leadership. The first category of ministries is the “**Caring Hearts Ministries**”.

The first area of ministry in this category is **Bereavement Lunches**. This is a benefit provided to all CFC members in the event of the loss of someone in their immediate family. A luncheon will be provided at CFC for the family following the funeral service. A family member should contact the church immediately upon a death in the family.

Another area of ministry under Caring Hearts is the “**Critically Ill and Funeral Support**”. Encouragement and support to those who are ill, have had surgery or lost a loved one are the recipients of this ministry. This is done via phone calls, prayers, cards and words of encouragement.

Individual Financial Helps exists to help CFC members meet needs in specific areas and to distribute love offerings in times of “pressing” financial needs.

The **Meals Ministry** provides meals to CFC members through times of illness, bereavement, birth of a child, etc. There are currently fifteen people who help provide food on an as needed basis to people in the congregation.

Prayer support is a vital part of our church’s mission. The **CFC Prayer Chain** members intercede for the needs of our church body through weekly prayer and fasting. Members are contacted via email or phone and can also meet throughout the week to pray. However, if you have a prayer request; email or phone the church office to submit it, or write it on the prayer request cards located at the front of the sanctuary and at the donation box in the foyer.

The **Widows’ Ministry** which reaches out to widow or widowers of the church.

All these ministries not only exist to meet the needs within the body of CFC, but also to provide areas of opportunity for involvement for members of our congregation. If you have a need that fits into one of these areas, please contact the church office to get “connected” to the ministry’s leaders.
